- How to Join the P.S.A. -

The Pacific Shooters Association (PSA) is a private club. New members must have a valid PAL or POL to join PSA. Persons interested in joining PSA should drop by the club on a Saturday or Sunday (9:30am-1:30pm), find a Director in the club house, fill out the membership application, issue membership fee payment and write the range exam.

The usual one-time initial sign-up fee of **\$100 is currently being waived**. The annual membership fee is **\$100** for individuals and **\$120** for family memberships. Family memberships allow for range use of another adult family member and any under age children.

Applicants need to complete a multiple choice exam which tests for knowledge of PSA club rules and safety procedures. Passing grade is 80%. After passing the exam, new members are on probation. A temporary membership is issued (yellow card) which allows for 5 range visits under the supervision of the acting Range Officer (to ensure safe firearm handling and abiding of club safety rules).

It is the responsibility of the probationary member to ensure that they are observed by the Range Officer for each of their initial 5 visits, and that the respective Range Officer signs one space on the yellow card after being satisfied of proper and safe firearms and range usage.

During one of their shooting sessions probationary members must demonstrate their ability to "run the firing line" to the Range Officer. This will involve them calling a cease fire, inspecting the line before turning the green lights on. When everyone is back behind the firing line they will then end the cease fire and turn off the green lights.

Once all 5 probationary visits have been signed off and if the Directors are satisfied with the candidate's general competence and safety habits, then full membership status is issued to the applicant.
